

Transfer Stations

- The items that each transfer station will accept will vary, so be sure to check out the following pages and call the contact number or the Conservation District if you have any questions.
- Terms to Know:
 - Waste – materials that cannot be recycled, donated, or reused and can safely be sent to the landfill (i.e. garbage)
 - Single Stream Recycling – recyclable plastics, paper, metals, and glass that are not sorted
 - Yard Waste – leaves, branches, and grass clippings
- Commonly Accepted Items (call to confirm if not listed):
 - Cardboard, Catalogs, Glass (blue, brown, clear, green, etc.), Magazines, Mattresses, Metal Cans, Metal Jar Lids, Newspapers, Paper, Phonebooks, Plastic

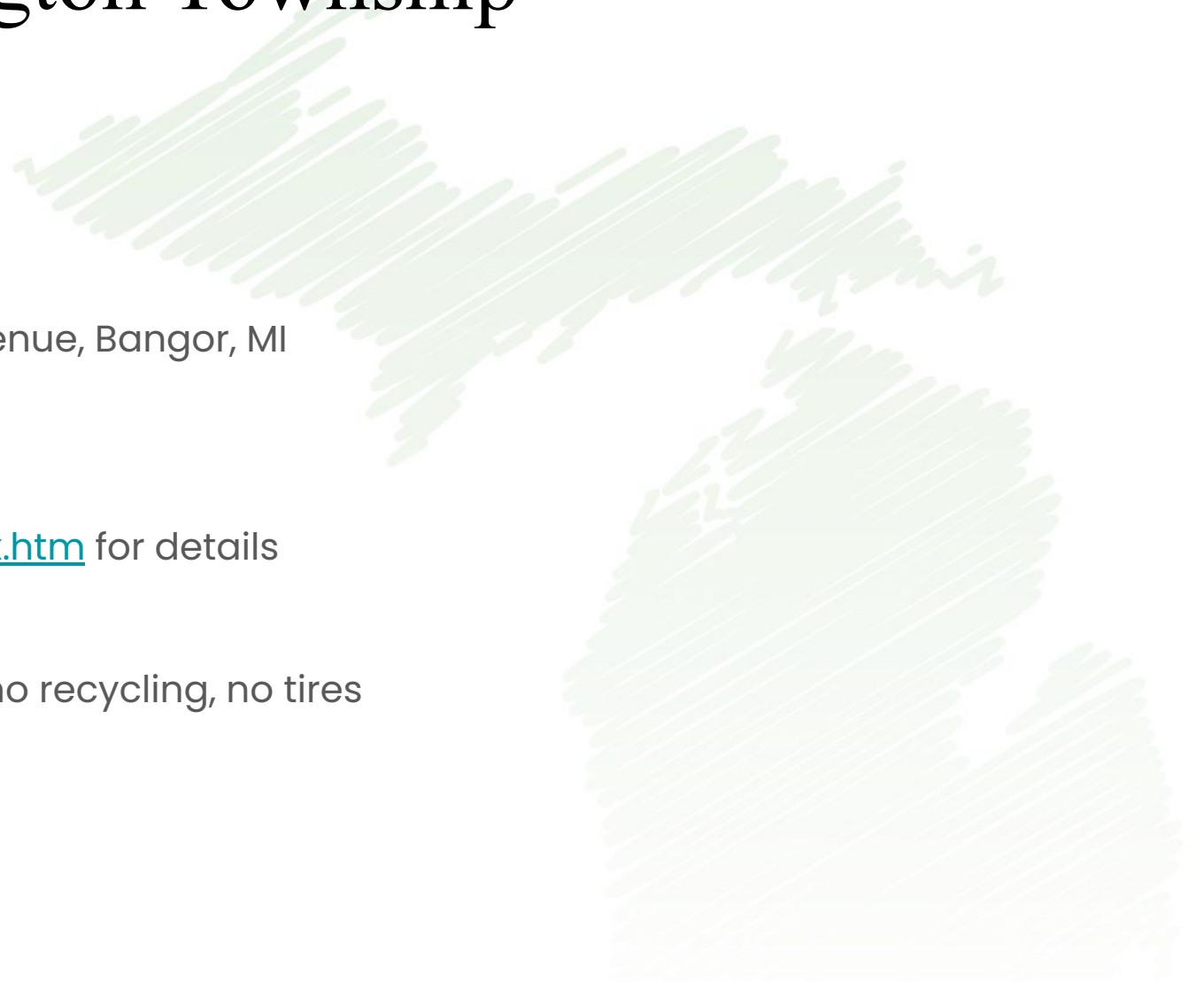
- #1 (e.g. soda bottles, water bottles, salad dressing bottles)
- #2 (e.g. milk jugs, laundry detergent, household cleaner bottles)
- #3 (e.g. shampoo bottles, cooking oil and peanut butter jars, window cleaner bottles)
- #4 (e.g. food storage containers, some condiment bottles)
- #5 (e.g. ketchup bottles, yogurt containers, straws)
- #6 (e.g. egg cartons, some food containers, disposable cups)
- #7 (e.g. some food containers, five gallon buckets, all-plastic toys)

- Open To:
 - Antwerp Township residents
- Location:
 - Southwest of Mattawan on the south side of 64th Avenue, between CR 657 and 30th Street in Antwerp Township
- Hours of Operation:
 - Tuesdays and Saturdays – 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM
- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste, Single Stream Recycling, Cardboard, Yard Waste (3x/year limit), Metal Recycling, Newspaper, Shingles

Transfer Station – Arlington Township

- Open To:
 - Arlington Township residents
- Location:
 - At the corner of 52nd Street and 26th Avenue, Bangor, MI
- Hours of Operation:
 - Two Dump Days per year

- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste only – no hazardous materials, no recycling, no tires

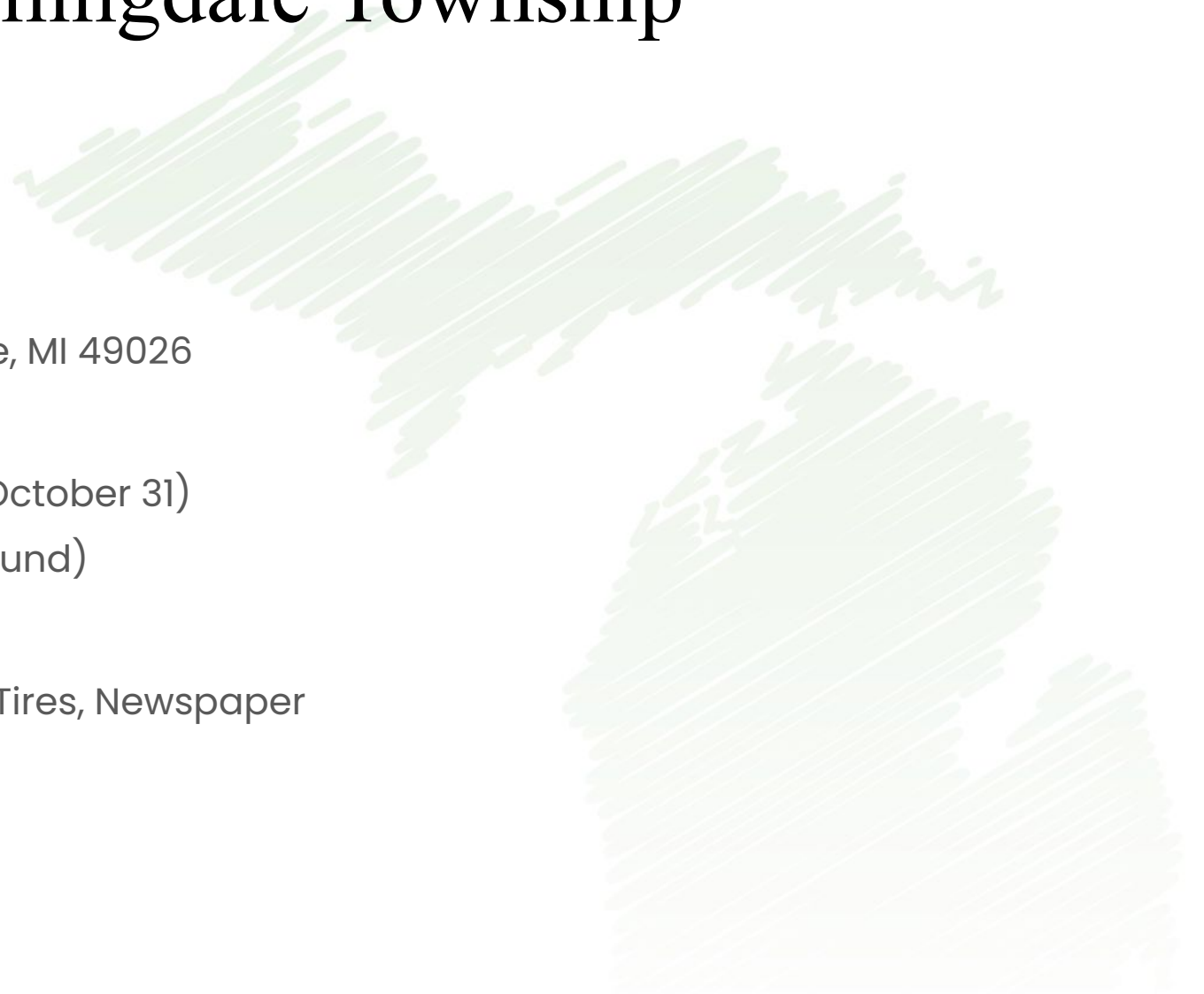


Transfer Station – Bangor Township

- Open To:
 - Bangor Township residents
- Location:
 - 41559 63rd Street, Bangor, MI 49013 (North of CR 376 on 63rd Street)
- Hours of Operation:
 - 1st and 3rd Saturday – 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM
- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste, Single Stream Recycling, Metal, Tires
- Contact:
 - (269) 427-8965
- Cost: (Dump permits can be purchased at the transfer station or the township hall with a check or money order)
 - Dump permit required - \$15 for 20 punches
 - Tires - \$2 per passenger tire, \$4 per truck tire, tractor tires accepted at the discretion of the attendant

- Open To:
 - All Van Buren County residents
- Location:
 - 109 W. Kalamazoo Street, Bloomingdale, MI 49026
- Hours of Operation:
 - Tuesday – 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM (April 1 – October 31)
 - Saturday – 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM (year-round)
- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste, Single Stream Recycling, Metal, Tires, Newspaper

Transfer Station – Columbia Township

- Open To:
 - Columbia Township residents
- Location:
 - 52 ½ Street, Breedsville, MI – a ½ mile north of CR 380
- Hours of Operation:
 - 1st Sunday of the month – 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM
 - Each Saturday following the first weekend of the month – 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM
- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste only – no hazardous materials, no recycling, no tires
- Contact:
 - (269) 434-6227
- Cost: (punch tickets can be picked up and purchased at the transfer station)
 - One free punch card with two punches per resident per year
 - Additional punch tickets – \$20

Transfer Station – Covert Township

- Open To:
 - Covert Township residents
- Location:
 - 76890 34th Avenue, Covert, MI 49043. (On 34th Ave., 1-1/4 mi, West of M-140)
- Hours of Operation:
 - Saturdays – 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM (Closed Holidays)
- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste and Single Stream Recycling
- Contact:

- Cost: (Punch cards can be purchased at the transfer station or the township hall)
 - 4 punch card – \$5
 - 10 punch card – \$10
 - Recycling – Free



Transfer Station – Geneva/South Haven

- Open To:
 - Geneva Township and South Haven Township residents
- Location:
 - On CR 384 East of M-43 Highway South Haven, MI 49090
- Hours of Operation:
 - Saturdays – 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM, Tuesdays 8 AM to 2 PM (Summer Hours)
- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste, Single Stream Recycling, Yard Waste
- Contact:

- Cost:
 - Free pass required – can be obtained at Township Hall
 - Without pass – \$3 per 18-gallon tote

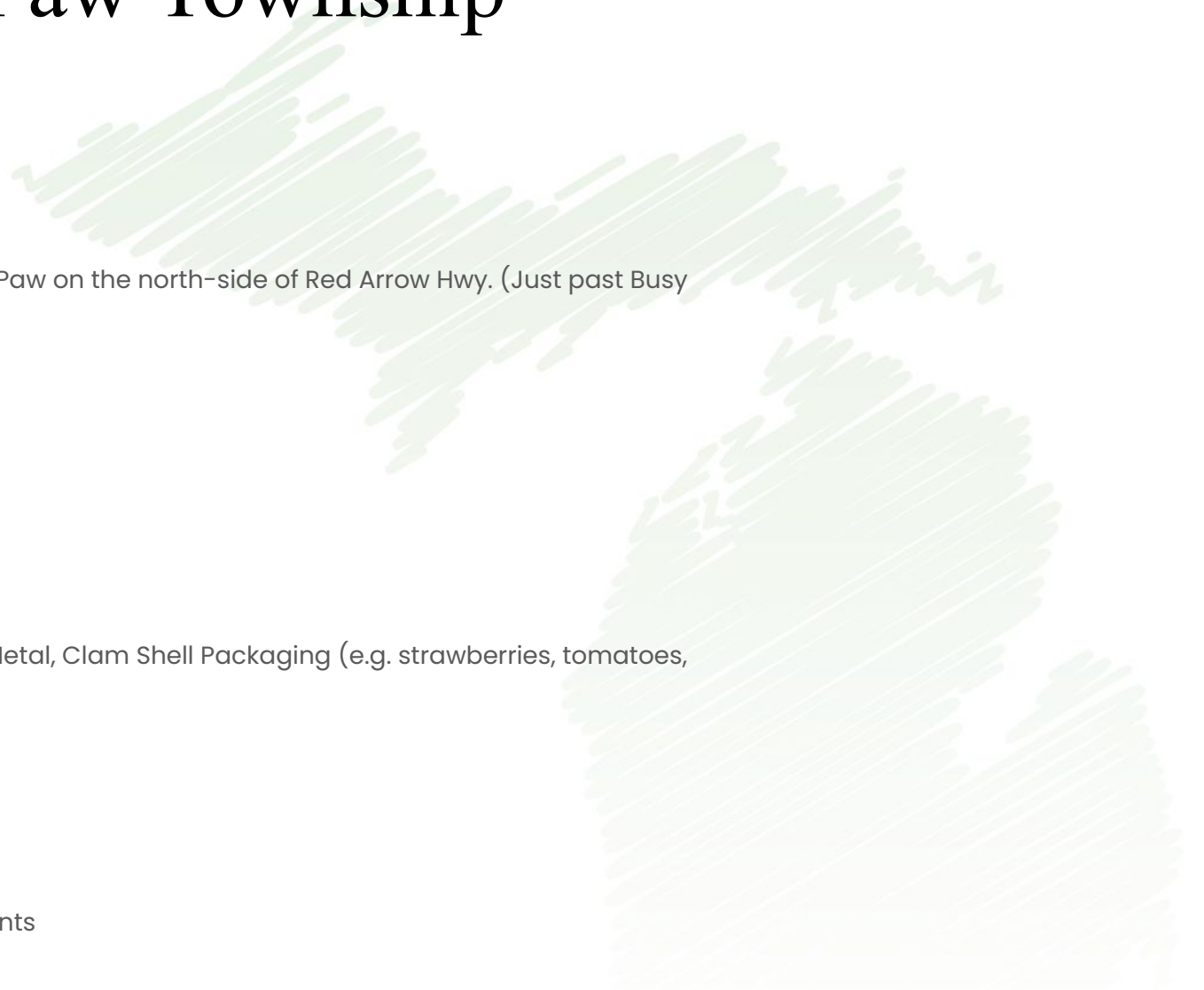
Transfer Station – Keeler Township

- Open To:
 - Keeler Township residents and Keeler Township property owners
- Location:
 - 1/2 mile south of Keeler on CR 687
- Hours of Operation:
 - Saturdays – 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM (April – October)
- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste (no recycling)
- Contact:

- Cost:
 - \$2/bag if dropped off
 - \$80/load if picked up (call to schedule)



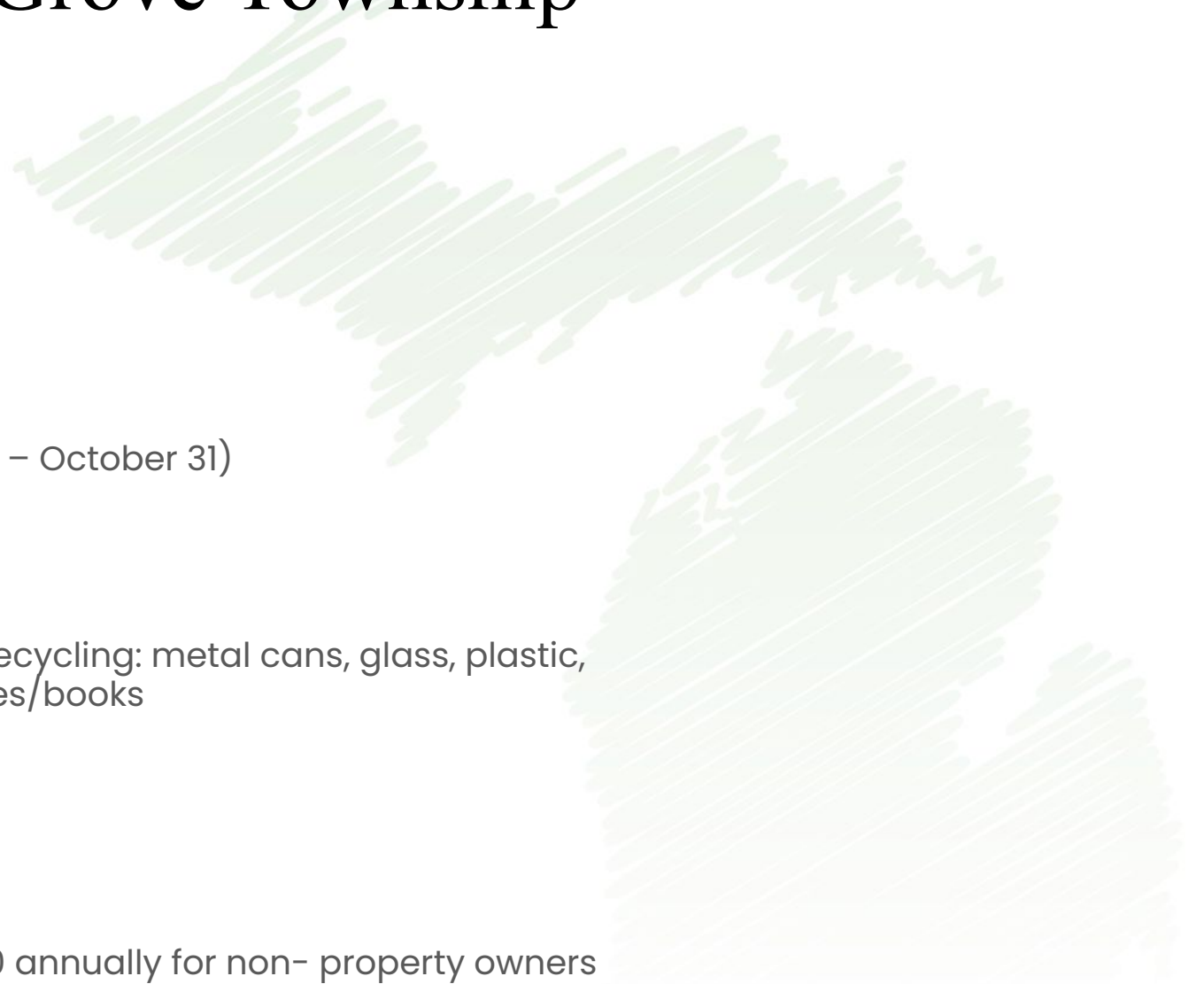
Transfer Station – Paw Paw Township

- Open To:
 - All Van Buren County residents (see cost)
- Location:
 - 38016 Red Arrow Highway, Paw Paw, MI 49079. West of Paw Paw on the north-side of Red Arrow Hwy. (Just past Busy Bee Flea Mall)
- Hours of Operation:
 - Tuesdays – 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM
 - Fridays – 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM (April-September)
 - Saturdays – 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM
- Accepted Materials:
 - Waste, Single Stream Recycling, Cardboard, Brush Waste, Metal, Clam Shell Packaging (e.g. strawberries, tomatoes, blueberries, etc.), Shingles
- Contact:

- Cost:
 - Free Recycle Pass available to all Paw Paw Township residents
 - Open to the public for a small fee

 - Waste (costs associated), Single Stream Recycling: metal cans, glass, plastic, cardboard, and bundled papers/magazines/books
